Criteria used to select the award recipient are as follows:

A sustained record of:

- leadership in science education
- advocacy for quality K-12 science education for all students
- contributions to STAT and other professional science organizations
- development of effective programs for pre-service and in-service teachers of science

Nomination Packet must contain (can be sent separately):

- one letter of nomination and two to five letters of support that describe how the nominee meets the criteria
- nominee's curriculum vitae

Letters and vitae need to indicate how the nominee meets each of the criteria above. The awardee will receive the Skoog Cup award at the STAT luncheon at CAST. The awardee will receive two tickets to the STAT luncheon.

Texas Tech will provide a \$500 honorarium and travel expenses to speak to faculty, teachers and students at the **Skoog Cup Luncheon** at Texas Tech during the award year.
